

Volunteering/Internship

Treat both internships and volunteer positions like a job search. Ideally, find an employer that might be a possible hire in the future, or a non-profit organization that will allow to utilize your current skills or develop new ones.

Volunteering and internships can provide practical knowledge to incorporate into your resume as current experience, and an additional avenue to network. Volunteer work can provides an opportunity to maintain and possibly learn new skills as well as to demonstrate abilities and capabilities – and to be a possible reference/referral source.

In addition, volunteering is another form of networking and typically you can set your own hours which enables you to pursue your job search.
